She and her husband, the Rev. Stephen M. Hall, rector of St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Brookings, will

become the first priest clergy couple in the Diocese of South Dakota.

Also, the actual ordination ceremony will include a concelebrated eucharist with the Halls, South Dakota Episcopal Bishop Craig B. Anderson and the Rev. Brian Gentz of St. John Lutheran Church in Madison.

The ceremony is set for 7 p.m. Sunday at St. John Lutheran Church. The public is invited to the ordination and the reception which will follow.

Since Jan. 1, Karen Hall has been serving the Episcopal congregations in Madison, DeSmet and Flandreau. At Sunday's ordination service, she will also officially be installed as vicar of the three churches. They comprise a wider area ministry, of which St. Paul's in Brookings is "the mother church," according to Stephen Hall. For more than 40 years, lay readers and priests from St. Paul's have been helping to provide services to the three smaller congregations.

Karen Hall's ordination represents the fruition and maturity of that wider ministry which has gone on for many years, her husband said.

She views her ordination in the setting of St. John Lutheran as a continuation of national ecumenical dialogue and also of some important shared ventures between Grace Episcopal Church and St. John's. Her

ordination as deacon last April 15 took place in Ascension Lutheran Church in Brookings.

The choir at the ordination service will include members from St. John's as well as St. Paul's and Grace Episcopal. The reception immediately after the service is a joint venture of the Lutheran and Episcopal churches involved.

Karen Hall is a graduate of the University of Colorado and has done additional graduate work at South Dakota State University and Nashotah House Seminary in Wisconsin.

"The church has long called me to an active participation, but in the last five years I have felt a call to the fuller role of the ministry," she said.

The past ten months of working in the wider area ministry "have convinced me that the call is valid," she said, "but it has also made me a lot more realistic about the challenges of a ministry in rural South Dakota. We are building on the long-term commitment of these people in these congregations."

The Halls said their being a clergy couple involved in a wider area ministry "will be a model" for the South Dakota Diocese. Because of the state's sparse population and great distances, this may well be a model that the bishop will follow in other parts of the state.
