Mr. Richards opened the meeting of the Bishop's Committee with prayer when they met at his home on January 9, 1962

Mr. Page reported that our quota is paid in full and we have a balance of \$320. in the treasury. Pandemonium insurance was discussed - a clause in the fire insurance policy was a possibility.

There were suggestions for memorials - doors, board, carpeting, credence table. We received \$35. from Marshall Swain, which was from our parishoners. It was agreed

to put this sum into our fund of \$2200. and to call it the Bruce Swain Memorial Fund.

Mr. Richards showed us some Lenten literature and it was decided to order some. The possibility of a quarterly news letter was discussed, containing a financial report, Guild news etc., to be mailed to all members.

The meeting was closed with prayer.

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The meeting of the Bishop's Committee of Grace Church was opened with prayer by Mr. Richards when they met in the Guild Hall on May 15, at 8 P.M. with five present.

The disposition of the old organ was discussed and it was decided to accept the offer of the Rev. Mr. Johnson of Good Shepherd to buy some of the ranks.

It was also decided to allow Mr. Richards \$10. for the purchase of some
