December 2, 1965

Meeting called to order by Fr. Richardson ^{who led the invocation}. Those present were Dean Hackett, Ted Newcomer, & Carolyn Bowes. Minutes read by Bill Mervin.

Treasurer's report by D. Hackett who suggested sending a letter to the bishop and exec. council ^{requesting} relief from part of our quota obligation. Approx. \$800.00 of the money promised thru pledges was not received this year. D. Hackett will write letter mentioned above, ~~explaining~~ Motion made to use the remainder of the ^{Powered Lamp} ^{(\$500.00) provided there is some left from previous} Fund for our quota ~~(as per budget)~~ The Vicar of the Bishop's Com. ^{to be consulted} will be consulted; those present were in favor.

Those who have made pledges for the coming year or who give regularly number 26 so far. Many have not been contacted by the Every Member Canvas.

Quota for '65 is \$1486 of which \$275. is paid. It was decided to give notice to each person the status of his pledge along with expressing the need for funds to meet our quota by including an envelope in this month's calendar to be mailed out this week.

The heating system is progressing. D. Hackett mentioned that the congregation should be informed

that money for the remodeling project has been collected.

Money already budgeted for cleaning help will be reckoned to provide secretarial help instead - 4 hrs. weekly at \$1.25 an hr.

Annual meeting set for 3rd Sunday of Jan.

It was suggested that hi school or college member be on Bishop's Comm., or a different representative each month.

Church attendance is up. Fr. Richards suggested a Family Service ^{excluding sermon} at 11:00, after which children go to Church School classes & adults meet informally in Guild Hall, this to be tried in Jan & Feb. Met with approval of those present.

Fr. Richards explained the Mutual Responsibility & Interdependence project, in which we will exchange resources with Polynesia.

Regular meeting night set for 2nd Thurs. of each month.

January 26, 1966

Called to order by Fr. Richards who led the invocation. All members were present. After the reading of the minutes, Treasurer Dean Hackett reported a balance of \$54.00.¹⁹⁶⁵ Quota paid amounted to \$475.00 with \$106.00 still to be paid.

The time for the annual meeting was set for Feb 13, 1966, Sunday at 5:30. The women of the church are to handle the food. Merrill Andes will preside at the business meeting during which ~~all~~ Bishop Committee members will report on some phase of the church's work in 1965.

The Committee suggested that a system be established by which 2 new members will be elected ^{each year} for a 3-year term ~~each year~~ to replace 2 outgoing members. One of the new members will be from the relatively newcomers to the congregation, the other from the more ~~long time~~ ^{longer} time residents. Carolyn Bowes & Dean Hackett were appointed to ask Jim Caughey and Francis Sly to accept nomination under this new ~~passed~~ system which received a favorable vote from the committee.
