

December 1, 1966, Bishop's Committee Meeting.

Present were Aly. Hackett, Bowers and Fr. Adams

Membership list checked for pledge cards received. The plate from the Men & Boys Corporate Communion will be sent to the Presiding Bishop's Relief Fund, the Thanksgiving Offering to Bishop Harv. Mission.

Members agreed that we should change our insurance on the church to Church Mutual Insur. Co. (Thirdeeman is agent). The new rate will be \$85.00 for \$10,500 on building and \$500.00 on contents. Rates with present company are \$104.00 for \$11,000.00 coverage.

Passed that Bev. Hunter see the Fire Chief about size of fire extinguishers needed for the church as well as number needed and to purchase them. She may check with members of B. Committee if she wishes before the purchase.

Moved and passed that we again ask for Myrna & Collin Harris to clean the church (They had resigned this job.) on the condition that some Gladys outline exactly the work expected of them, pay \$10.00^{per} month based on 2 hrs of work a week.

Treasurer Hackett presented bills.

Annual meeting will be Jan. 29.

New B. Committee members will be elected then. Collin Harris and Mrs. Donald Boyd will be contacted to serve the next 3 years. Motion made & carried that a 7th member be elected by the Women's Guild.

Fr. Adams announced that the Dec. 18 service will be a carol service, both laymen reading the lessons and the sermon omitted.

extinguisher for the bottom of the stairway (by kitchen). Bill
N. announced that we should get the basement cleaned up.
He will ^{at annual meeting that} announce a work party will be planned for Feb.

It was moved & seconded to ask David Adams to clean the
church at \$10.00 a month and that he submit bills for work
on lawn & shoveling of walks at a rate of \$1.00 per hour. Carried.

It was suggested that the Sun School could buy pine oaks or
other planting around Arbor Day with the weekly offerings.
Harry Bowes will be asked to check on fire escape at East Hall.

Confirmation will be April 30. Convocation
delegates will be picked later by Bishop's Committee.

It was decided to ^{recommend} ~~mention~~ to the new Bishop's
Committee that they follow the suggestion of the Executive
Council which was that we pay what we can on
our quota each month rather than wait till the
end of the year to try and scrape up the full amount.

It was moved & seconded that we keep the \$600.00
reserve fund (made up of income from the vicarage
while it was rented to the Davids) as an account for
unexpected expenses or ~~to~~ pay on the quota if necessary
at the end of the year. Motion carried.

Fr. Adams announced the Jan 20 the Thank
off prayer service will be at our church with Holy
Communion at 6:30 and 8:00. Ushers will be needed.
