John Johnson reported on the price of the carpet, plus the pad and stripping of openings and installation was to exceed \$550.00 dollars.

motion by Rev, seconded by Lola that we purchase the carpet, motion carried.

Lola made a ~~motion~~ suggestion that we buy a spiral bound hymnal for the organ with Greg Ketchum's money. motion by Rev, seconded by Eric motion carried.

Lola reported that the bill for the stave will be sent plus an extra grat and will be paid for by Memorial Fund from Bell McClellan for less than \$500.

The amount to be paid the organist was set at \$15.00 per service motion by Rev. accounted by Jean Baptist motion carried.

It was reported by Eric that the organ needs repairs or be replaced. He will check on the price of buying one.

Merrill reported on the old furnace and says it is in need of a good cleaning and to repair a leak.

He says the big problem is getting the present taxes out.

Eric will talk to her pastor to see about getting her to move.

It was reported that an standing committee will be appointed by the Bishop for the sale of the Rectory. There being no other business the meeting adjourned.
