There was a meeting for members of Grace Episcopal Church held following church services. The meeting was conducted by Merrill Hunter.

First business taken up was changing the time of the service for the summer months Motion was made by Eric Johnson, seconded by Berniece Rethorn that we change the time to nine A. M. a vote was then taken on whether it should be nine or ten. The vote ended in favor of ker nine.

He also reported that that Father Thornburn from Brookings, Father Weston of Flandreau and Father Wright of Sioux Falls will all be available at some time. It is the wish of the members of Grace Church to no longer have Father Taylor of Soo Center Ia.

A motion by Mr. Delay seconded by Susan Lauck that the Bishops Committee handle



this situation. The motion carried.

A meeting of the Bishops Committee will be held following church services next Sunday June 8, 1980.

There being no other business the meeting adjourned.
