Motion by Johnson and second by F. Stewart to accept the treasurer's report as distributed. Motion carried. The balance as of March 18 is \$25.83.

Brewer will make sure that the church is on the budget plan for our monthly phone bill.

Fr. Al was involved in church centennial activities in a previous parish, so he will check his files for information and get back to us with some ideas.

A couple of dates were set for money raising activities. A church rummage sale will be held on Sat., June 2. Fr. Al will ask Flandreau if they are interested in a joint food booth at Art in the Park on Sat., June 16.

Fr. Al appointed Brewer as the church's evangelism contact person.

There was much positive response from the group on Fr. Al's instruction sessions in lieu of sermons on the last two Sundays.

Easter Vigil with feast service will begin at Grace at 6:00 p.m. on Sat., April 14. Fr. Al explained the service, and he will write it out so we can see the flow. He will check with Flandreau on March 20 to see if they plan to participate in the service.

Johnson expressed dissatisfaction with the current Sunday school curriculum and will investigate some alternatives.

Fr. Al asked that we think about the possibility of having summer Sunday services on alternate Sundays at 9 a.m.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
