Monday, May 21, 1990

Hunter called the meeting to order at 7:45 p.m.

The minutes of the April 23 meeting stand approved as distributed.

Hunter announced that we would have regular church services on May 27 and June 3. On June 10 Fr. Lewis will have a service and potluck for Flandreau and Madison at his home in Sioux Falls. We begin our 9 a.m. summer services on June 17.

The interest that accrued in April for two quarters on the church's CD was \$516.74. This was given to treasurer Ruby Stewart to put into the checking account.

The treasurer reported a balance of \$505.04. Motion by DeLay and second by Sanford to accept the treasurer's report as distributed. Motion carried.

Hunter expressed appreciation to the guild for all the time and effort it put into making their anniversary celebration at the church a success.

The guild will have a rummage sale at the church on Sat., June 2 from 8 a.m. until 2 p.m.

DeLay has made arrangements to pay for the lawn mowing this summer and will pay for it through the treasurer. Motion by Hunter and second by Johnson to accept his offer. Motion carried.

Business next month will include discussion of the seminary stipend for Mo. Karen and discussion of the Mid-Continental Restoration Co.'s report on the exterior building repairs. Hunter will write the company to inquire as to how much it will cost to take down the granite wall, replace the foundation and replace the wall.

Hunter will also begin running off the fund-raising material.

Motion by DeLay and second by Brewer to run all the funds acquired through the fund-raising efforts through the treasurer. Motion carried.

Sanford will check on the possibility of a car wash at Spies on June 9 as a fund-raiser for the young people.

Johnson asked that we think about what we as a church could do for her son John Jr. who is now at the State Penitentiary. Motion by DeLay and second by Sanford to try to have Mo. Karen visit him in the prison for religious purposes. Motion carried. Brewer will take responsibility for sending him cards on appropriate occasions.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
